LGBTQ+ Awareness Evaluation, University of Oslo, 2022

This course was designed as an introductory program to inform the students who (will) work with LGBTQI+ individuals about the core concepts related to sexual (affectional) orientation and gender identity, the interview principles, contemporary approaches and to let them question homonegative approaches and practices. Students learned to analyse and understand contemporary issues of LGBTQI+ community through historical and contemporary perspectives.

This course examined contemporary theorizing and empirical research in psychological science related to the lives and experiences of intersex, queer, transgender, lesbian, gay, and bisexual individuals, couples, families, and communities. We discussed topics such as: coming out, heteronormativity, heterosexism, anti-LGBTQI+ stigma, dynamics of same-sex attraction & relationships, transgender issues, intersectionality, LGBTQI+ mental health, and LGBTQI+ wellbeing, in global contexts.

All numeric ratings are made on a 7-point scale ranging from 1 (strongly disagree) to 7 (strongly agree). Below are the numeric scores for the fifteen items that best speak to my teaching goals along with comments from students from my LGBTQI+ class at Oslo University.
