Examination

- Individual, written assignment
- 4-hour written exam.

The assignment and exam will be evaluated concurrently by one assessment committee and only one grade will be assigned based on this comprehensive evaluation. The written assignment and the exam normally account for approximately 40 and 60 percent of the final grade, respectively. However, the assessment committee may give more weight to the written assignment in circumstances in which the result is between two grades.

In order to pass the course, a passing grade must be achieved on both the written assignment and the exam in the same semester. The result will be assigned on a scale from A to F.

School exam

The written school exam consists of two parts. Parts one and two account for onethird and two-thirds of the grade, respectively. In order to receive a passing grade on the exam, candidates must complete and pass both parts.
