

1. In no more than 3 pages, please provide a concise and clear description of the question addressed by the project/article, stating the hypotheses and predictions and/or goals of the project. Include a clear description of the conception and design of the project, how acquisition of data is going to (or did) take place (e.g., number of subjects, how many, etc.), methods and procedure, and how the analysis and interpretation of data is going to be (or was) performed.
2. Declare in a separate short section at the end of the 3-page document why the project is 'interesting' and why NFR should give you a salary for carrying out this specific project. Think and say in one or two lines what you believe is the relevance of the study/project/article for the research field and for society.
3. Conclude the 3-page document by stating what is your role in the project as well as that of the supervisor in the thinking, planning and designing of the project, as well as your role in the analysis of the data and the preparation of a manuscript.

Projects will be prioritized that fulfill the following requirements:

- 1) The project's idea is original or novel within the field
- 2) The project seems to rely on a good design and method
- 3) The project is feasible within the limited time covered by the stipend
- 4) The student shows a reasonable degree of independency to carry out the project
- 5) The project is supported by a supervisor who is one of the PSI faculty members
- 6) Applications from differing fields of research and different projects/supervisors will be preferred to several applications linked to the same project/supervisor.
